Do you have depression and/or a recent history of concussion?

Psychiatry researchers at St. Michael's Hospital are studying the **links between concussion and depression**. They will try to identify markers that can predict risk of depression following a concussion.



Study participation includes completion of attention and memory tests, brain imaging and questionnaires about your mood.

We are currently recruiting the following groups of people:

- 1) People with a **recent concussion** (in the past 3-6 months)
- 2) People who have been diagnosed with **Major Depressive Disorder**
- 3) People with a recent **concussion and Major Depressive Disorder**
- 4) People with no psychiatric history and no history of concussion
