

Seeking participants for a neuroimaging research study on depression

Psychiatry researchers at St. Michael's Hospital are conducting a study to look for characteristics of brain structure and function in individuals with major depressive disorder (MDD) that are associated with suicide risk. We are also seeking individuals without MDD for comparison.

Participants in this study will be asked to complete:

- Questionnaires about your mood
- A 2-hour clinical interview
- A 1-hour magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) scan



You may be eligible to participate if you:

- Are between 18 and 65 years old
- Are currently diagnosed with major depression
- Have no current medical illness
- Have ever contemplated suicide or made an attempt
